Marty Cetron, a member of Arbor's board of trustees, and parent of students Bryce and Rachel, and graduate Josh, was written up in the *Boston Globe* on Monday, August 31. A portion of the report notes, "[... Cetron, an avuncular official here at the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, is telling his kids to wash their hands and cover their coughs. He's talking about the importance of vaccination. And he's trumpeting a measure used through the ages to stanch the migration of viruses: Stay home when you're sick. 'What I try to point out to my kids is that by doing this for yourself, by staying home when you're sick and giving up that party or that swim meet, not only are you likely to get better quicker because you're not stressing your immune system, but you're being a better citizen to your friends,' said Cetron, director of CDC's Division of Global Migration and Quarantine."]
