Early Morning Care 2010-2011

Arbor offers early morning drop-off at both locations for children of all ages on an annual contract basis. Drop-ins will be accepted if there is space. You must call the office by the end of the day prior to drop-in.

Cost: \$648 for the year, payable in 9 monthly installments of \$72, September to May
First Payment Due: September 1, 2010
Time: Emory Campus @ 8:00 a.m., Central Campus @ 7:30 a.m.
Contract Due: Thursday, May 20, 2010
Begins: Monday, August 23, 2010 for all ages

If we receive more applications than available spaces by the May 20th deadline, Early Morning Care will be assigned by lottery. Families will receive one lottery slip that will cover all children in their family. To be included in the lottery, sign the Early Morning Care Contract and return it to the office by 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 20 (faxes NOT accepted). We will contact you with the results of the lottery by Tuesday, May 25.

Bus Service Between Campuses

Each morning and afternoon our bus carries a maximum of 14 students between Central Campus and the Emory Campus. This service is provided on an annual contract basis. Students must be five years of age or older to ride the shuttlebus between campuses. Drop-ins will be accepted if there is space. You must call the office by the end of the day prior to drop-in.

Cost One-Way: \$684 for the year, payable in 9 monthly installments of \$76, September to May
(EMORY FIVE-YEAR-OLDS ENROLLED IN THE ENRICHMENT PROGRAM RIDE THE BUS AT NO EXTRA COST)
Cost Roundtrip: \$1368 for the year, payable in 9 monthly installments of \$152, September to May
Cost for Drop-In: \$10 one-way (only if there is space)
First Payment Due: September 1, 2010
Time: Depart Emory Campus parking lot promptly at **7:50 a.m.** and **3:15 p.m.**
Depart Central Campus parking lot at **3:00 p.m.** to arrive at Emory
Contract Due: Thursday, May 20, 2010
Begins: Monday, August 23, 2010

PLEASE NOTE: THE BUS WILL NOT STOP TO PICKUP RIDERS AFTER THE DRIVER HAS CLOSED THE DOOR AND THE BUS IS IN MOTION.

If we receive more applications than available spaces by the May 20th deadline, bus seats will be assigned by lottery using these guidelines:

1. Round-trip and staff contracts will receive priority.
2. Families will receive one lottery slip that will cover all children in their family.
3. The lottery will also determine the waitlist.

To be included in the lottery, sign the Bus Service Contract and return it to the office by 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 20 (faxes NOT accepted). We will contact you with the results of the lottery by Tuesday, May 25.
