Transportation Safety Form

Georgia law requires that children under 8 years of age be secured in an approved car seat or booster seat while riding in private vehicles. The car seat and/or booster seat must be in the rear seat, be appropriate for the child's weight and height, meet all U.S. federal standards, and be installed and used according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Exemption: Children under 8 years old whose height is over 57 inches (4 feet 9 inches).

Does your child require a toddler seat or booster seat rather than a seat belt on school trips in private vehicles? (Booster seats are not required for the Arbor bus.)

Yes, I will supply the toddler seat or booster seat for trips.

(Please realize that if your child does not have the required restraint, she/he will not be able to go on trips.)

No, my child's height is over 4 feet 9 inches or she/he is older than 8 years.

I give my permission for basic first-aid measures for my child and in the case of more serious injury for emergency medical treatment. If my child requires a car restraint, I will furnish it.
